

## DRESS CODE FOR PUBLIC WREATH CEREMONIES

Personal appearance and dress of persons participating in ceremonies at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier will adhere to dress standards expected of such dignified occasions. At a minimum, the following dress code will be followed.

### MALES

A collared shirt  
Casual slacks  
Appropriate shoes

### FEMALES

A blouse  
Casual slacks, skirt or dress  
Appropriate shoes

The following attire is considered not to be appropriate for participation in the ceremonies:

Blue jeans  
Patched pants  
Shorts of any kind  
Tank tops  
Halter tops  
Tee shirts  
Shower type shoes  
Tube tops  
Shirts that expose the midriff

The Superintendent, Arlington National Cemetery, or his representatives, the Sergeant of the Guard, and Relief Commanders have the authority to prohibit a person in non appropriate attire from participating in a wreath ceremony at The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.
