Dear Wyneken Students and Parents:

This year I will be offering a trip to Gettysburg and Washington, D.C. for eighth grade students. Classic Tours of Auburn will be making the arrangements for us. This trip is school-sponsored and all school rules and regulations will apply. The trip will be chaperoned by teachers and other adults as needed.

We will depart from Wyneken Lutheran School the evening of Monday, May 4, via motor coach. We will arrive in Gettysburg the following morning. After a tour of the battlefield we will continue on to Washington. We will check into our hotel that evening. We will leave Washington the evening of Friday, May 8, and arrive back at Wyneken Lutheran School early the next morning, Saturday, May 9.

Accommodations for our group will be at a deluxe hotel in the Washington area. You may select your roommates.

Our meals will be at large food courts, cafeterias and buffet style restaurants. You will be responsible for lunch on Tuesday. All other meals are included. There is a \$7 allowance for each of your three lunches. Each lunch will be in a food court. Depending on the restaurant you chose you may require additional lunch money.

The student cost is \$634.00 per student and includes transportation, accommodations for three nights (quad occupancy), eleven meals, sightseeing and admissions, group picture, evening activities and accident insurance (\$2500.00). Adult costs are as follows: quad occupancy-\$659.00; triple-\$693.00; double-\$761.00; single-\$965.00. These prices are based on a minimum of 35 participants per motor coach. If the number signed up for the trip falls below the minimum, an adjustment will have to be made in the trip cost or in the trip itself.

Highlights of our trip will include a tour of the Gettysburg battlefield; a night tour of the memorials; visits to Arlington National Cemetery and Mount Vernon in Virginia; an evening at the ESPN Zone; several hours in the Smithsonian Institute museum complex and much more.

I am confident that a visit to Washington will provide a unique learning experience, as well as a valuable insight into our nation's history and government. If you have questions not answered by this letter or the enclosure, please feel free to call me at school.

Deadline for receipt of deposit is **JANUARY 12, 2009**. Payments may be made at any time with the final payment due **MARCH 20, 2009**. I recommend that you make reservations as soon as possible. **THE NUMBER OF RESERVATIONS ACCEPTED IS LIMITED BY BUS SIZE AND WILL BE BASED ON THE DATE DEPOSITS ARE RECEIVED.**
