Remember the determination of need is based upon your Adjusted Gross Income.** Only our business assistant and principal will see these tax documents to ensure privacy for our families. *Please note that a separate application is required for each child. Each application must be completed in its entirety, and each application must have proof of current income attached.* If you need a new application, copies are available in the school office or may be found at www.wyneken.org. **Please contact the school office with any questions.**
