All forms and a completed application must be in the school office by this date. **When you submit your application, please also provide a copy of the first page of your 2021 Federal Tax Return -1040 with the Household size and Adjusted Gross Income as documentation of your income. Remember the determination of need is based upon your Adjusted Gross Income.** Only our business assistant, Mrs. Cheryl Reinking and principal will see these tax documents to ensure privacy for our families. *Please note that a separate application is required for each child.
