**Illness Policy:** The school should be notified immediately of a communicable disease. All children are to be excluded from school for a communicable disease or a condition that is readily transmitted to others. A written permit from the doctor is required when a child returns to school after recovering from any communicable disease. If a child has an acute upper respiratory infection, sore throat, earache, upset stomach, or an elevated temperature of 100 degrees or more, the student should be kept home or will be sent home. Children should remain home for A FULL 24 HOURS following an episode of fever or vomiting to ensure full recovery.
