All applicants for the teacher sub position must have a valid sub teaching license with the state of Indiana. All applicants will also have to complete an Expanded Criminal Background Check.

Delays and Closings: Wyneken Lutheran School will be announced for all delays and closings. We do not announce under North Adams Community Schools. Weather delays/closings are reported on most area radio and TV channels. You can also check on our school website, www.wyneken.org, and our Facebook page for information. You are encouraged to sign up for our text reminders – as notifications are also sent thru the text alerts. To receive messages via text, text **@wynparents** to **81010**.

All after school activities, including any sports games/practices, are canceled when school is canceled. Check our website page at www.wyneken.org or our school Facebook page for information.

Visits to School: All visitors, including parents, must check in at the office. If a parent or other adult is dropping off an item for a student (homework, lunch, clothing/shoes, birthday treat, etc.) it is to be left in the school office and will be delivered by school personnel to the student. Birthday treats, flowers/balloons are to be left at the office and will be delivered to the student. The parent/adult is not permitted to go directly to the classroom to deliver any items or talk to a student.

Students with Food Allergies: Students who have any type of food allergies are to have a prescription from the child's doctor stating what the food allergy is and it will be kept on file in the office. We will need to share this information with your child's teacher and with the kitchen staff.

Tardiness Policy: Unless arriving by North Adams bus, a tardy is defined as a late arrival to Wyneken - after 8:00AM up through 8:59AM. This means students must be inside the building at the 8:00AM bell. Students arriving after 8:00AM must report to the school office to receive a tardy slip BEFORE going to their classroom.

Illness Policy: The school should be notified immediately of a communicable disease. All children are to be excluded from school for a communicable disease or a condition that is readily transmitted to others. A written permit from the doctor is required when a child returns to school after recovering from any communicable disease.

If a child has an acute upper respiratory infection, sore throat, earache, upset stomach, or an elevated temperature of 100 degrees or more, the student should be kept home or will be sent home. Children should remain home for A FULL 24 HOURS following an episode of fever or vomiting to ensure full recovery.
