The application deadline for the 2023-2024 school year is by noon on June 1, 2023. All forms and a completed application must be in the school office by this date. When you submit your application, please also provide a copy of the first page of your 2022 Federal Tax Return -1040 with the Household size and Adjusted Gross Income as documentation of your income. Remember the determination of need is based upon your Adjusted Gross Income. Only our business assistant and principal will see these tax documents to ensure privacy for our families. Please note that a separate application is required for each child. Each application must be completed in its entirety, and each application must have proof of current income attached.
