- **Looking Ahead-** Summer office hours beginning May 27 will be 8am – 11:30am, other times will be available by appointment; School registrations/information for 2022-2023 school year will be mailed in mid-July; Registration day is August 4; First day of 2022-23 school year is August 10 for Kindergarten-8<sup>th</sup> grades; August 16 for Pre-K; August 18 for Preschool.
- **SGO Applications Due June 1 - We encourage all families to apply.** The application deadline for the 2022-2023 school year is by noon on June 1, 2022. All forms and a completed application must be in the school office by this date. **When you submit your application, please also provide a copy of the first page of your 2021 Federal Tax Return -1040 with the Household size and Adjusted Gross Income as documentation of your income. Remember the determination of need is based upon your Adjusted Gross Income.** Only our business assistant and principal will see these tax documents to ensure privacy for our families. *Please note that a separate application is required for each child. Each application must be completed in its entirety, and each application must have proof of current income attached.* If you need a new application, contact the school office or visit [www.wyneken.org](http://www.wyneken.org). **Please contact the school office with any questions.**
- **Final Report Cards-** End of Year report cards will be mailed to ALL families of K-8<sup>th</sup> grades within a two-week time period after May 26. Included with the report card will be a school supply list for 2022-23 and other important information from your child's teacher. The 2022-2023 calendar is on the Wyneken website, [www.wyneken.org](http://www.wyneken.org). *Report cards will be withheld and records will not be forwarded to new schools for families who have any outstanding fees.*
- **Wyneken Hot Lunch Information-** The school hot lunch program is currently funded by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). Since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic, school corporations across the country have been operating with the use of a federal waiver that allowed them to feed every child for free through the end of this school year. **The use of this waiver will not be available after this school year and corporations will return to the traditional eligibility requirements for free, reduced and paid meals. This means that for School Year 2022-2023, our school corporation will process free and reduced-price meal benefit applications.** The Food Services Department does have the ability to Directly Certify students who receive SNAP, TANF, some Medicaid, are certified as homeless, migrant, or are wards of the state (foster children). Households who are found to be directly certified will be notified in writing of the free or reduced-price meal status prior to the start of school and will not need to complete an application. Meal benefit applications will not be available until July 1\*. Households are encouraged to apply before the start of the school year to avoid unpaid meal charges.
- **The Wyneken Athletics Varsity Sports Banquet** will be held on Sunday June 5th at 7:00 pm in the Wyneken Cafeteria. Please join us as we celebrate the 2021-2022 school year varsity athletics teams. Families are asked to bring a desert or light dish to share. Beverages will be provided.
