#### 1. Ferrous Scrap Metals:

These include iron and steel-based materials.

##### **Old Appliances, Cars and Car Parts, Farm Equipment:**

Tractors, plows, and other machinery.

#### 2. Non-Ferrous Scrap Metals:

These do not contain iron and are often more valuable.

**Copper:** Wires, pipes, and other copper items.

**Aluminum:** Cans, window frames, and other aluminum products.

**Brass:** Plumbing fixtures, keys, and decorative items.

**Stainless Steel:** Kitchen appliances, cutlery, and industrial equipment.
